Upon motion of Mr. Mark Poche, duly seconded by Mr. Ernal "E. J." Broussard, and unanimously carried, the Police Jury appointed Ms. Ann Dozier to fill the position of Secretary for the Parishwide Road Maintenance Department.

Upon motion of Mr. Purvis Abshire, duly seconded by Mr. Kenneth DeHart, and unanimously carried, the Police Jury appointed Ms. Karen Crosby to fill the position of Manager for the Rabies Control Program.

Upon motion of Mr. Purvis Abshire, duly seconded by Mr. Minos Broussard, and unanimously carried, the Police Jury appointed Mr. Rodney Roy to fill the position of Animal Control Officer in the Rabies Control Program.

Upon motion of Mr. Mark Poche, duly seconded by Mr. Terry Bessard, and unanimously carried, the Police Jury approved repair of the damage claim from USDA for damages to one of their trucks driven by Mr. Blue Bouillion. Damages were sustained due to work being performed on Harris Lane. The purchasing agent was authorized to issue a purchase order to Car Service Center, Inc. to do the repairs at a cost of \$3,133.62.
