Upon motion of Mr. Maxwell Chreene, duly seconded by Mr. Gaulman Gaspard, and unanimously carried, the Police Jury approved going into executive session at 7:04 p.m. to discuss the status of the Toter Manufacturing vs. VPPJ litigation.

AS A RESULT OF A PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON MARCH 22, 2004, THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE RESPECTFULLY SUBMITTED FOR THE JURY'S CONSIDERATION:

1. It is recommended that Mr. William Noegel be hired as the mosquito control program assistant supervisor at a salary of \$2,500.00 per month, with the understanding that he will pursue entomology courses needed to qualify to obtain an 8D certification.
2. It is recommended that the Ms. Antoinette Derouen be retained as a part time interim supervisor/monitor for the mosquito control program at an hourly rate of \$35.00, up to \$1,500.00 per month.
3. It is recommended that the commercial garbage collection rate charges be increased by \$15.00 per month, with new rates to become effective July 1, 2004.
