WHEREAS, much evaluation and preparatory planning has already been done, representing a further investment by the State, and the project is ready to move on to the next phase of construction; and

WHEREAS, the final construction of Palmetto Island State Park will bring about a much needed economic boost for Vermilion Parish and our surrounding parishes; and

WHEREAS, the State of Louisiana is experiencing an ever increasing number of tourists who are looking for camp sites in a natural setting surrounded by an abundance of local culture and history; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Vermilion Parish Police Jury, duly assembled, does hereby resoundingly endorse and hereby request the funding for the final phase of construction for Palmetto Island State Park be approved; and requests that the Commissioner of Administration proceed as necessary to advance this project.
