**RESOLUTION

A Resolution Authorizing the President and Secretary-Treasurer to Obtain Interim Financing for Excessive Debris Caused by Hurricane Lili

WHEREAS, the Vermilion Parish Police Jury has received extensive damage due to Hurricane Lili, and

WHEREAS, the debris developed from Hurricane Lili was in excess of normal debris produced in the Parish, and

WHEREAS, the Vermilion Parish Police Jury will incur a significant cost in the clearing of this debris, and

WHEREAS, the Vermilion Parish Police Jury does not have financing for the up front cost of this project, and

WHEREAS, it will be necessary for the Vermilion Parish Police Jury to obtain interim short-term financing to proceed with this project.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the President, Edval Simon, Jr., and the Secretary-Treasurer, Michael J. Bertrand, be authorized to take the necessary steps to obtain interim financing not to exceed \$1,500,000 and, if necessary, to obtain authorization from the bond and tax commission of the State of Louisiana.
