**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM
THE STATE OF LOUISIANA TO PROVIDE FOR
THE AGGREGATE SURFACING OF
A PORTION OF BLUEBONNET ROAD
IN VERMILION PARISH, LOUISIANA**

WHEREAS, the western portion of Bluebonnet Road is a roadway used by motorist to access homes, farming interests, recreational hunting interests, and the oil and gas industry; and

WHEREAS, because of the traffic usage and the small tax base, road surface material is not sufficient to provide a safe means of ingress and egress to this area, especially during high rainfall periods; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Vermilion Parish Police Jury to take corrective action to provide aggregate material and prevent further deterioration of this road; and

WHEREAS, the Police Jury does not have the financial capacity at this time to fund these much needed improvements.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Vermilion Parish Police Jury, that the State of Louisiana, Office of Rural Development is hereby requested to provide financial assistance in the amount of \$12,500.00 to assist the Police Jury in resurfacing Bluebonnet Road.

THEREUPON, the above resolution was declared adopted.
