

## RESOLUTIONS – 2003

- 2003-R-1 Resolution authorizing the President to execute and file an application with the Department of Transportation and Development on behalf of Vermilion Parish to aid in the financing of operating assistance projects pursuant to the Rural Public Transit Programs, 49 CFR 5311, adopted January 21, 2003.

- 2003-R-5 The resolution requesting the Congress of the United States to review the GPO and WEP social security benefit reductions and to consider eliminating them. Whereas the Congress of the United States in 1983 which enacted both the Government Pension Offset (GPO)- reducing the spousal and survivor social security benefit, and the Windfall Elimination Provision (WEP)- reducing the earned social security benefit for persons who also receive a state or local government retirement. Adopted January 21, 2003.
- 2003-R-6 A resolution authorizing the President to execute an Act of Acceptance from Teche Construction Co., Inc. pertaining to the completion of the contract for the "Hurricane Lili – Debris Removal from approved private properties – Right Of Entry Contract – Proposal A". Adopted February 18, 2003.
- 2003-R-7 A resolution to support the continuation of the Office of Rural Development and oppose House Bill No. 56 during the 2003 Regular Session which would abolish the Office of Rural Development and the Office of Urban Affairs and Development and prohibit such offices from being recreated and the powers, functions, duties and responsibilities thereof from being exercised or reassigned, adopted March 3, 2003.

- 2003-R-8 Authorizing the issuance, sale and deliver of \$2,265,000 of Water Revenue Bonds, Series 2004A, of Waterworks District No. 1 of the Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana, and other matters relating thereto, including to provide interim financing for said District's waterworks project (Indian Bayou), and the issuance, sale and delivery of \$2,265,000 of Bond Anticipation Notes, Series 2003A, of said District, adopted April 7, 2003.
- 2003-R-9 Authorizing the issuance, sale and deliver of \$2,193,000 of Water Revenue Bonds, Series 2004B, of Waterworks District No. 1 of the Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana, and other matters relating thereto, including to provide interim financing for said District's waterworks project (Intracoastal City, Esther and Forked Island), and the issuance, sale and delivery of \$2,193,000 of Bond Anticipation Notes, Series 2003B, of said District, adopted April 7, 2003.
- 2003-R-10 Requesting the parish legislative delegation to support local administration and collection of sales and use taxes, and support the package of bills sponsored by Senator Bill Jones which will develop a uniform tax code, adopted April 21, 2003.
- 2003-R-11 Approving the holding of an election in the Seventh Ward Gravity Drainage District No. 2 on Saturday, May 3, 2003, to authorize the levy of a special tax therein, adopted April 21, 2003.

- 2003-R-34 Resolution expressing strong opposition to any negotiations for the Central American Free Trade Agreement (CAFTA) which would remove portions of the tariff system affecting imported sugar, as such negotiations would destroy Louisiana’s sugar industry, adopted December 1, 2003.
- 2003-R-35 Resolution requesting financial assistance from the State of Louisiana for erosion protection measures on the Attakapa Ridge Subdivision outfall channel at the Vermilion River.
