

Upon motion of Mr. Edval Simon, Jr., duly seconded by Mr. Wayne Touchet, and unanimously carried, the Vermilion Parish Police Jury adopted the following resolution to levy millage rates for the year 2004 tax year for the taxing districts listed below:

**RESOLUTION
2004-R-9**

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Police Jury of the Parish of Vermilion, Louisiana, in public hearing held on July 19, 2004, which hearing was conducted in accordance with the open meetings law and additional requirements of Article VII, Section 23 (C) of the Constitution, that the taxing authority voted to increase the millage rates, but not in excess of the prior year's maximum rates, on all taxable property shown on the official assessment roll for the year 2004, and when collected, the revenues from said taxes shall be used only for the specific purposes for which said taxes have been levied. Said millage rates are:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Assessor of the Parish of Vermilion shall extend upon the assessment roll for the year 2004, the taxes herein levied, and the tax collector of said Parish shall collect and remit the same to said taxing authority in accordance with law.

This foregoing resolution was read in full, the roll was called on the adoption thereof, and the resolution was adopted by no less than two-thirds of the total membership of the taxing authority voting in favor as required by Article VIII, Section 23 (C) of the Louisiana Constitution and R.S. 47:1705 (B).
