A resolution providing for canvassing the returns and declaring the results of the special elections held in the (i) Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana, (ii) Road District No. 1 of the Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana, (iii) Road District No. 4-A of the Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana, (iv) Road District No. 6 of the Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana, and (v) Sub-Road District No. 1 of Road District No. 2 of the Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana, on Tuesday, November 2, 2004, to authorize the levy of special taxes therein.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Police Jury of the Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of the (i) Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana (the "Parish"), (ii) Road District No. 1 of the Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana, (iii) Road District No. 4-A of the Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana, (iv) Road District No. 6 of the Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana, and (v) Sub-Road District No. 1 of Road District No. 2 of the Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana (the "Districts"), that:

SECTION 1. Canvass. This Governing Authority does now proceed in open and public session to examine the official tabulations of votes cast at the special elections held in the Parish and Districts on TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 2004, to authorize the levy of special taxes therein, and said Governing Authority does further proceed to examine and canvass the returns and declare the results of the special elections.

SECTION 2. ProclIs Verbal. A *ProclIs Verbal* of the canvass of the returns of each of the elections shall be made and a certified copy thereof shall be forwarded to the Secretary of State, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, who shall record the same in his office; another certified copy of each shall be forwarded to the Clerk of Court and *Ex-Officio* Recorder of Mortgages in and for the Parish of Vermilion, who shall record the same in the Mortgage Records of said Parish; and another copy of each shall be retained in the archives of this Governing Authority.

SECTION 3. Promulgation of Election Results. The results of said elections shall be promulgated by publication in the manner provided by law.
