- 2005-R-1 Resolution authorizing the President to execute and file an application with the Department of Transportation and Development on behalf of Vermilion Parish to aid in the financing of capital assistance projects pursuant to the Rural Public Transit Programs, 49 CFR 5309, adopted February 7, 2005.
- 2005-R-02 Resolution granting the authority to the president to sign an intergovernmental cooperative agreement with Waterworks District No. 1 of Vermilion Parish relative to the 2003 La. Community Development Block Grant Program, adopted January 24, 2005.
- 2005-R-03 Resolution requesting support of the Community Development Block Program from our Congressional Delegation, adopted February 22, 2005.
- 2005-R-04 Resolution making an application to the Louisiana State Bond Commission for consent and authority to issue, sell and deliver, not exceeding Three Million Eight Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$3,830,000.00) of General Obligation Refunding Bonds, Series 2005, and providing for other matters in connection therewith. This would allow refunding of the bonds sold to construct the Library, adopted February 22, 2005.
- 2005-R-05 A resolution providing for the incurring of debt and issuance of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) of Certificates of Indebtedness, Series 2005 (the “Certificates”), of the Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana; prescribing the form, terms and conditions of the Certificates; designating the date, denomination and place of payment thereof in principal and interest; authorizing the agreement with the Paying Agent; providing for the employment of Bond Counsel; providing for the acceptance of an offer for the purchase of the Certificates; and providing for other matters in connection therewith., adopted, March 7, 2005.
- 2005-R-06 A resolution fro Ms. Betty Chambers, adopted March 7, 2005.
- 2005-R-07 A resolution providing for the issuance and sale of Three Million Eight Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$3,830,000.00) of General Obligation Refunding Bonds, Series 2005.
- 2005-R-08 A resolution ordering and calling a special election to be held in the Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana, to authorize the levy of a special tax therein; and providing for other matters in connection therewith, adopted March 21, 2005.
- 2005-R-09 Adopting procurement procedures relative to the Louisiana Community Development Block Program. (Adopted 4/18/05)
- 2005-R-10 Authorizing parish officials/employees to sign the request for payment forms for the Louisiana Community Development Block Grant Program. (Adopted 4/18/05)

- 2005-R-14 RESOLUTION OPPOSING ANY CHANGES IN PARISH EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM BENEFITS FOR EXISTING PARISH EMPLOYEES AND TO FURTHER REQUEST THAT THE PLAN CHANGE BE APPLIED TO ONLY NEW EMPLOYEES WHO ARE HIRED AFTER JANUARY 2, 2006. (Adopted 5/2/05)
- 2005-R-15 Adopted the adjusted millage rates for the year 2005. (Adopted June 20, 2005)
- 2005-R-16 Adopted the adjusted millage after assessment, and roll forward the millage to a rate not to exceed the prior year's maximum millage for the year 2005. (Adopted June 20, 2005)
- 2005-R-17 A resolution providing for canvassing the returns and declaring the result of the special election held in the Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana, on Saturday, July 16, 2005, to authorize the levy of a special tax therein. (Adopted 8-1-05)
- 2005-R-18 A resolution to levy the Library Maintenance Tax for the Year 2005. (Adopted 8-15-05)
- 2005-R-19 The Police Jury approved a proclamation and resolution to set an election date for the Police Juror in Election District No. 7. Adopted 8/15/05

- 2005-R-24 A resolution providing for the sale of not exceeding Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) of Revenue Anticipation Notes of the Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana; and providing for other matters in connection therewith.
- 2005-R-25 Annual Certification of Compliance With State Of Louisiana Off System Bridge Replacement Program, adopted November 21, 2005.
- 2005-R-26 A resolution making application to the Louisiana State Bond Commission for approval of the issuance by the Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana, of not exceeding Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) of Revenue Anticipation Notes, and providing for other matters in connection therewith. Adopted 11-7-05.
- 2005-R-27 Resolution No 2005-R-27 from the November 7, 2005 meeting be approved, said item acknowledging receipt of and approving an application from Allen & Kirmse, Ltd. dated November 2, 2005, for an oil, gas and other minerals lease covering all right, title and interest belonging to the Vermilion Parish Police Jury in and to the roads and road rights-of-way located within the following sections and portions of sections, all located in Vermilion Parish, Louisiana: The South Half (S/2) of Section 24, Township 12 South, Range 1 East; All of Section 25, Township 12 South, Range 1 East; The South Half (S/2) of Section 19, Township 12 South, Range 2 East; All of Section 30, Township 12 South, Range 2 East; **less-and-except** therefrom any lands located within the geographic boundaries of the ALL RC SUA, Conservation Order No. 557-J-4, Kaplan Field, and within the geographic boundaries of the CAM 1 RC SUA, Conservation Order No. 557-E-20, Kaplan Field., all as set forth and described in said application, and further authorizing and requesting the Louisiana Department of Natural Resources, Office of Mineral Resources, State Mineral Board, to act on behalf of the Vermilion Parish Police Jury in advertising and leasing said tract for exploration,

development and production of oil, gas and other minerals, and further authorizing Clay P. Menard, the Secretary/Treasurer, to endorse in favor of the Office of Mineral Resources, Allen & Kirmse, Ltd.'s check made payable to the Vermilion Parish Police Jury in the amount of \$400.00, all in accordance with the provisions of LA R.S. 30:153.
