BE IT RESOLVED, by the Police Jury of the Parish of Vermilion, Louisiana, in public hearing held on June 20, 2005, which hearing was conducted in accordance with the open meetings law and the additional requirements of Article VII, Section 23 (C) of the Constitution, that the following adjusted millage rates be, and they are hereby levied upon the dollar of the assessed valuation of all property subject to ad valorem taxation within said Parish for the year 2005, for the purpose of raising revenue:
