WHEREAS, Ernal "E.J." Broussard has submitted his resignation as Police Juror of the Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana, effective August 10, 2005 at 11:59 p.m. and it has been accepted by the Vermilion Parish Police Jury.

WHEREAS, his resignation has caused a vacancy in office and an election must be ordered and called to fill the unexpired term of office exceeding one year; and

WHEREAS, the governing authority of Vermilion Parish, Louisiana, is given the authority and responsibility under the provisions of La. R.S. 18:602 to appoint a person to fill the vacancy who meet the qualifications of the office, and to call a special election to fill the vacancy.

NOW THEREFORE, that a special election be called and held with the special Primary election date set for April 1, 2005, and the special General Election date set for April 29, 2005, with qualifying dates set for February 8, 9, and 10 of 2005.
