WHEREAS, the Vermilion Parish Police Jury has received grant funds from the Federal Emergency Management Agency, through the Louisiana Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness, for the preparation of a hazard mitigation plan and;

WHEREAS, our parish has participated in the process to prepare a DMA compliant Hazard Mitigation Plan based on the FEMA guidance available in the How to Guides and;

WHEREAS, our parish wishes to participate in the Hazard Mitigation Plan prepared by the Vermilion Parish government under the oversight of the Steering Committee comprised of Parish-wide representatives and;

WHEREAS, Vermilion Parish and local city representatives and governments have participated in the mitigation planning process and;

WHEREAS, appropriate opportunity for input by public and community officials has been provided through press releases, open meetings and availability of draft documents and;

WHEREAS, the Plan has been recommended for adoption by the Steering Committee and;

WHEREAS, adoption of the Plan is required prior to further consideration for FEMA funding under the following programs:

- Pre-Disaster Mitigation
- Hazard Mitigation Grant Program
- Flood Mitigation Assistance Program

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Vermilion Parish Police Jury does hereby adopt the Vermilion Parish Hazard Mitigation Plan on 7th day of November, 2005.
