A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A RESIDENTIAL
ANTIDISPLACEMENT AND RELOCATION ASSISTANCE PLAN
AND APPOINTING MR. MARK POCHÉ
AS ANTIDISPLACEMENT/RELOCATION OFFICER
RELATIVE TO THE
LOUISIANA COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Vermilion Parish Police Jury has been awarded a Fiscal Year 2005 Louisiana Community Development Block Grant under the Disaster Recovery Program; and

WHEREAS, on October 1, 1988, new requirements for a Residential Antidisplacement and Relocation Assistance Plan under the Federal Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 became effective; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development will not award any Community Development Block Grant funds after October 1, 1988 unless a community adopts such a plan; and

WHEREAS, the Vermilion Parish Police Jury requires the services of one person to be the contact person relative to displacements and relocation pertaining to the Louisiana Community Development Block Grant program.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Vermilion Parish Police Jury to adopt such a plan and appoint such an officer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Vermilion Parish Police Jury that the attached Residential Antidisplacement and Relocation Assistance Plan is hereby adopted in connection with the Louisiana Community Development Block Grant Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Mark Poché, or his successor, is hereby appointed as the antidisplacement/relocation officer relative to the Louisiana Community Development Block Grant Program.

THEREUPON, the above resolution was duly adopted.
