A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A SECTION 504 POLICY STATEMENT
AND APPOINTING THE VERMILION PARISH POLICE JURY PRESIDENT
AS ACCESSIBILITY COMPLIANCE OFFICER
FOR THE
LOUISIANA COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Vermilion Parish Police Jury has been awarded a Fiscal Year 2006 Louisiana Community Development Block Grant; and

WHEREAS, the Vermilion Parish Police Jury is committed to compliance with Section 504 and the Accessibility Standards for Disabled Persons for the Louisiana Community Development Block Grant Program as set forth by the federal government and the Louisiana Division of Administration; and

WHEREAS, the Vermilion Parish Police Jury requires the services of one person to coordinate compliance with non-discrimination requirements contained in the Department of Housing & Urban Development's regulations implementing Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1974, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Vermilion Parish Police Jury desires to adopt a Section 504 Policy Statement; and

WHEREAS, the Vermilion Parish Police Jury desires to adopt complaint procedures for the Americans with Disabilities Act.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Vermilion Parish Police Jury that the President of the Vermilion Parish Police Jury be appointed to coordinate the Section 504 efforts and act as the Accessibility Compliance Officer for the Louisiana Community Development Block Grant and perform all necessary tasks as associated with this position.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the attached Section 504 Policy Statement which includes Complaint Procedures for Section 504 and the Americans with Disabilities Act are hereby adopted.

THEREUPON, the above resolution was duly adopted.
