RELATIVE TO THE  
LOUISIANA COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM

**WHEREAS**, the Vermilion Parish Police Jury has been awarded a Fiscal Year 2006 Louisiana Community Development Block Grant Program; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 1, 1988, new requirements for a Residential Antidisplacement and Relocation Assistance Plan under the Federal Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 became effective; and

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development will not award any Community Development Block Grant funds after October 1, 1988 unless a community adopts such a plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Vermilion Parish Police Jury requires the services of one person to be the contact person relative to displacements and relocation pertaining to the Louisiana Community Development Block Grant program.

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the Vermilion Parish Police Jury to adopt such a plan and appoint such an officer.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Vermilion Parish Police Jury that the attached Residential Antidisplacement and Relocation Assistance Plan is hereby adopted in connection with the Louisiana Community Development Block Grant Program.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the President of the Vermilion Parish Police Jury is hereby appointed as the antidisplacement/relocation officer relative to the Louisiana Community Development Block Grant Program.

**THEREUPON**, the above resolution was duly adopted.
