WHEREAS, the Vermilion Parish Police Jury has been awarded a Fiscal Year 2006 Louisiana Community Development Block Grant; and

WHEREAS, under the Louisiana Community Development Block Grant Program, a written procurement must be adopted which complies with the federal regulations pursuant to the Standards Governing State and Local Grantee Procurement as set forth in the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Circular A-102, Attachment O and 24 CFR 85.36; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and proper to comply with the requirements for maximum open and free competition for procurement transactions.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Vermilion Parish Police Jury that the "Procurement Procedures of the Vermilion Parish Police Jury Relative to the Louisiana Community Development Block Grant Program" which are attached to and made a part of this resolution are to be followed by any employee responsible for procurement of services, supplies, equipment or construction obtained with funds from the Louisiana Community Development Block Grant Program.
