WHEREAS, the Louisiana Office of Community Development has announced that applications are being accepted for the Fiscal Year 2006-2007 Louisiana Government Assistance Program; and

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Government Assistance Program offers grants to eligible municipalities and parishes for a wide range of projects to improve public health, public safety, living conditions and for economic development purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Police Jury is eligible for a grant up to \$100,000.00; and
