Resolution opposing the building of the Associated Marine Institute near the Vermilion/Lafayette Parish Line.

WHEREAS, the Vermilion Parish Police Jury having been notified of the intent to build the Associated Marine Institute, a juvenile jail/home school, in Lafayette Parish; and

WHEREAS, this institute will be located ½ mile from the Indian Bayou Community in Vermilion Parish; and

WHEREAS, the individuals who will attend this institute will be adjudicated juveniles convicted of crimes; and

WHEREAS, the firm building the school has no plans to build a fence or enclosure of any kind around the school; and

WHEREAS, the residents of Indian Bayou are deeply concerned regarding their personal safety,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Vermilion Parish Police Jury that it opposes the building of such an institute.
