

**RESOLUTION

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE HOLDING OF AN ELECTION IN  
FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 07  
OF THE PARISH OF VERMILION, STATE OF LOUISIANA,  
ON SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 17, 2007,  
TO AUTHORIZE THE LEVY OF A SPECIAL TAX THEREIN.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of Fire Protection District No. 07 of the Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of Fire Protection District No. 07 of the Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana (the "District"), adopted a resolution on August 16, 2007, calling a special election in the District on Saturday, November 17, 2007, to authorize the levy of a special tax therein; and

**WHEREAS**, the governing authority of the District has requested that his Police Jury, acting as the governing authority of the Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana, give its consent and authority for the District to hold the aforesaid election, and in the event the election carries to levy and collect the special tax provided for therein; and

**WHEREAS**, as required by Article VI, Section 15 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, it is now the desire of this Police Jury to approve the holding of said election and in the event the election carries, to levy and collect the special tax provided for therein;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Police Jury of the Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana, acting as the governing authority of said Parish, that:

**SECTION 1.** In compliance with the provisions of Article VI, Section 15 of the constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, and in accordance with the request of the Board of Commissioners of Fire Protection District No. 07 of the Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana, this Police Jury hereby approves the holding of an election in the District, on Saturday, November 17, 2007, at which election there will be submitted the following proposition, to-wit:

**PROPOSITION (TAX CONTINUATION)**

**SUMMARY: 10 YEAR, 9.25 MILLS PROPERTY TAX CONTINUATION FOR ACQUIRING, CONSTRUCTING, IMPROVING, MAINTAINING AND/OR OPERATING FIRE PROTECTION FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT IN AND FOR THE DISTRICT, AND PAYING THE COST OF OBTAINING WATER FOR FIRE PROTECTION PURPOSES.**

Shall Fire Protection District No. 07 of the Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana (the "District"), be authorized to continue to levy a special tax of nine and twenty-five hundredths (9.25) mills (the estimated amount reasonably expected to be collected from the levy of the tax for one entire year being \$247,065.00) on all the property subject to taxation in the District for a period of ten (10) years, beginning with the year 2008 and ending with the year 2017, for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining and/or operating fire protection facilities and equipment in and for the District, and paying the cost of obtaining water for fire protection purposes?

**SECTION 2.** In the event the election carries, this Police Jury does hereby further consent to and authorize the District to levy and collect the special tax provided for therein.
