**RESOLUTION**

**2008-R-03**

A resolution approving the issuance, sale and delivery of not exceeding Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000), in the form of Revenue Anticipation Notes, Series 2008, of Hospital Service District No. 2 of the Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana, and other matters relating thereto.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Hospital Service District No. 2 of the Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana (the "Issuer"), by resolution adopted on February 13, 2008, authorized the issuance of not exceeding Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000) in the form of Revenue Anticipation Notes, Series 2008 (the "Notes"), for the purpose of paying the costs of current operations for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2008, pursuant to and under the authority conferred by Section 1430 of Title 39 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended, and other applicable constitutional and statutory authority; and

WHEREAS, it is now the desire of the Police Jury of the Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana, to approve the issuance of the Notes

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Police Jury of the Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana (the "Police Jury"), acting as the governing authority of the Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana (the "Parish), that:

SECTION 1. In compliance with the provisions of Article VI, Section 15 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, and Part XII, Chapter 2, Title 33 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended, and in accordance with the request of the Board of Commissioners of Hospital Service District No. 2 of the Parish of Vermilion, State of Louisiana (the "Issuer"), this Police Jury hereby approves the issuance of not exceeding Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000), in the form of Revenue Anticipation Notes, Series 2008 (the "Notes), of the Issuer, said Notes to be issued under the authority and for the purpose stated in the preamble hereto.

SECTION 2. Neither the Parish nor this Police Jury shall be liable in any manner for the payment of the Notes.
