**A RESOLUTION CERTIFYING THAT THE URGENT NEED
NATIONAL OBJECTIVE IS BEING MET UNDER THE
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT
DISASTER RECOVERY PROGRAM THROUGH THE
LOUISIANA LONG TERM COMMUNITY RECOVERY PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Vermilion Parish Police Jury has submitted several applications for funding under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Long Term Community Recovery Program; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Housing & Urban Development regulations require that the Police Jury certify that these activities for which CDBG funds are being requested are designed to alleviate existing conditions which pose a serious and immediate threat to the health or welfare of the community; which are of recent origin or which recently became urgent, and that the Vermilion Parish Police Jury is unable to finance the activity on its own, and that no other funds are available and on November 3, 2008 the Police Jury adopted a Resolution to that effect for the following four (4) projects:

Parish Bridge Replacement Project
Maurice Drainage Improvements Project
Delcambre Street Improvements Project
Erath Street Improvements Project

WHEREAS, the Police Jury has filed additional applications under the Long Term Community Recovery Program and desires to adopt a similar certification for:

Gueydan Drainage Improvements to the Pumping Station Project
Erath New Fire Station Project
Delcambre Elevated Municipal Office Project

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Vermilion Parish Police Jury hereby certifies that the activities for which CDBG funds are being requested for these three (3) additionally listed projects/applications are designed to alleviate existing conditions which pose a serious and immediate threat to the health or welfare of the community; are of recent origin or which recently became urgent and that the Vermilion Parish Police Jury is unable to finance the activity on its own and there are no other funds available.

THEREUPON, the above resolution was declared adopted.
